Allagash White (Portland, ME) 25oz

From Rob Tod of Allagash Brewing in Portland, Maine (New England's original Belgian-style brewery) comes this traditional Belgian-style Wheat Beer. Allagash White is very refreshing and especially good during the warmer months. Brewed with a generous portion of wheat and Allagash's own special blend of spices, this beer is light and slightly cloudy in appearance, with a spicy aroma. 5.2% alc vol

Allagash Dubbel Reserve (Portland, ME) 25oz

A hazy dark-amber, medium bodied Belgian-style 'Dubbel.' The combination of seven different malts, a special sugar, and a Belgian yeast strain result in a hearty beer with a complex, malty taste and a remarkably clean finish. 7% alc vol

Allagash Grand Cru (Portland, ME) 25oz

this is Allagash's winter seasonal — though it's fantastic year-round - a Belgian strong pale ale, deep-gold in color, with a full yet refined malty palate and gentle fruit & spice aroma. 7.2% alc vol

Allagash Black (Portland, ME) 25oz

A Belgian style stout, brewed with German 2 row barley, Torrified wheat and oats, balanced by a large addition of Belgian dark candi to give the Black a full and silky mouthfeel. Roasted malts give this stout its classic chocolate, toast and malty taste, and contribute to chocolate notes and a hint of roasted coffee in the aroma. The Black is fermented with a Belgian yeast strain and refermented in the bottle with the *methode champenoise* to make this beer truly unique. 7.5% alc vol

Boon Kriek 12oz

Brewed in Lembeek, the town that gave Lambic its name, by Frank Boon, premiere revivalist brewer in Belgium. Kriek is Flemish for cherry. The beer is 100% spontaneously fermented by wild yeast, and then barrel aged for 2 years. Cherries are added after 18 months, lending the beer its tart, cherry pie-like flavor. Renowned for its delicacy, balance, this is the original of all fruit beers. 5% alc vol

Cantillon Classic Gueuze 25oz

Cantillon Gueuze - certified organic - is a perfect blend of one, two, and three year-old lambics. Tart and slightly acidic, this is the real champagne of beers. It's fermented with wild airborne yeasts from the Senne Valley in Brussels and is then aged in centuries-old oak casks. During the late winter and early spring, the Cantillon family matches and blends one, two, and three-year old casks to create a balanced flavor. The end product is called "gueuze." A few months in the bottle "conditions" the beer – building carbonation, and concentrating and organizing the flavors.

Chimay Red 25oz

A Trappiste beer (produced by Cistercian monks of the Scourmont Abbey) this Belgian dubbel has a copper color topped with a creamy head. Their secret yeast produces the slight aroma of apricots, and tastes of dried fruits. It finishes with a nice dryness. Has a great mouth feel thanks to bottle conditioning. 7% alc vol

Dogfish Head 60-minute IPA (Milton, DE) 12oz

crafted by Sam Calagione of the Dogfish Head Brewery in Lewes, Delaware, the "60-minute IPA" is a hop lovers' dream—hops are continuously added to the brewing kettle for a full sixty minutes, producing a big 60+ IBU India Pale Ale. 6% alc vol

Dogfish Head Indian Brown Ale (Milton, DE) 12oz

The Indian Brown Ale is a cross between a Scotch Ale, an I.P.A., and an American Pale. This ruby-colored beer is both well hopped and bursting with malt; brewed with Aromatic Barley and caramelized brown sugar. 7.2% alc vol

Dogfish Head Raison D'Etire (Milton, DE) 12oz

A big brown ale brewed with whole leaf high alpha magnum, eroica, & fuggels hops. A second smaller kettle is used for the adjunct boil of Belgian beet sugar & raisins. 8% alc vol

Hennepin Farmhouse Saison Ale (Cooperstown, NY) 25oz

Brewed at Ommegang in Cooperstown, New York, an authentic Belgian-style brewery – they're owned by Belgium's Mortgaat (producers of the great Duvel). The "Hennepin" (Father Hennepin was the Belgian missionary who discovered Niagara Falls) is a Grisette farmhouse ale – pale, hoppy, and crisp, with a rustic fruitiness. Like all of Ommegang's award-winning beers, this one is bottle conditioned 7.7% alc vol

Jolly Pumpkin La Roja (Dexter, MI) 25oz

An artisan amber ale brewed in the Flanders tradition. Deep amber with earthy caramel, spice, and sour fruit notes developed through natural barrel aging. Unfiltered, unpasteurized and blended from barrels ranging in age from two to ten months. 7.2% alc vol

Kerkom Brewery Bink Blond 11.2oz

Brewer Marc Limet is trying to bring the heavy use of hops back into Belgian brewing. His blonde is actually more of a cross between a farmhouse ale and an IPA. Dry-hopped, it pours out with a lovely golden color, slightly hazy, and with plenty of spice and malt flavor considering it's only 5.5% in alcohol. Comes from one of the most beautiful farmhouse breweries in Belgium, situated in a gorgeous cherry orchard.

Long Trail Double Bag (Bridgewater, VT) 12oz

Brewed right up the road, this strong ale is full and rich, with a malty body balanced by three generous additions of noble hops. The flavor is sweet caramel accented by grassy and herbal hops, and a slightly earthy finish. 7.2% alc vol

Mönchshof Schwarz (Kulmbacher Brewery) 17oz

Here's the question: how can such a dark, rich-tasting beer be so light and easy to drink? From Germany's Kulmbacher Brewery, this is the best "black beer" in the world. Also known as the "Black Pils" because of its dryness, Mönchshof (pronounced "Moonks-Hoff," which means "monastery," in honor of the monks who originally founded the brewery) has a flowery hop bitterness that sets it apart from all others. It's full of dark, roasted, slightly chocolate flavors that are astounding in such a refreshing beer. Beer writer Michael gave it four stars and declared it a world classic. 4.9% alc vol

Otter Creek Stovepipe Porter (Middlebury, VT) 12oz

A pitch dark beer, this Vermont porter is rich, chocolaty, and smooth. Nice balance between malt and hops. One of the best porters out there.

Rare Vos Belgian Style Amber (Cooperstown, NY) 25oz

Another fine Belgian-style ale from the Omegang Brewery, the Rare Vos ("Sly Fox") has a sweetly fruity malt character and a yeasty spiciness. 6.5% alc vol

Rock Art Ridge Runner (Morrisville, VT) 12oz

Also from Vermont, this beer is made with six different malts and four hops. The aroma is nuts and chocolate, while the flavor is toasted malts and grain along with hints of cocoa, nuts, and caramel. 7.5% alc vol

Rodenbach 25oz

A Flemish sour ale from Belgium, young Rodenbach is mixed with Rodenbach that has aged for two years in oak casks, producing a red mahogany beer that's both sweet and sour, with hints of tart apples and cherries. Has a light mouth feel with a refreshing finish. 5.1% alc vol

Saison Dupont Belgian Farmhouse Ale 25oz

Considered one of the top 5 beers in the world, this Belgian Farmhouse Ale is hoppy, herbal and fresh, with strong notes of pepper and a lively fruitiness. Features a big, refreshing, fruity flavor that develops to a finish that's clean, smooth and dry. This is a classic, with a mellow earthy spiciness. 6.5% alc vol

Smuttynose IPA (Portsmouth, NH) 12oz

This particular IPA was created to have more hop flavor and aroma than bitterness, more mouth-feel than astringency. It starts with a big dry hop nose, which leads in to a citrus and spicy/herbal taste balanced ever so lightly by a hint of malt sweetness. But no matter how you put it, this IPA is all hop goodness. 6.6% alc vol

Smuttynose Portsmouth Lager (Portsmouth, NH) 12oz

It's a full-flavored, medium bodied continental-style beer - deep golden in color, featuring mouth-pleasing malt character subtly balanced with spicy Saaz hops. One taste of this fine lager tells you this is no ordinary beer: from its mellow, velvety body to its lingering, fresh hop finish, Portsmouth Lager is smooth, complex and satisfying. 4.5% alc vol
